**SACYR BEGINS WORK ON LINE 2 OF THE SAO PAULO METRO
IN BRAZIL**

- **The 7.3 km project has a value of 443 million euros and a construction period of 69 months.**
- **It will benefit more than 300,000 daily users.**

Sao Paulo, January 22, 2020. Sacyr Infrastructures and Engineering has begun construction work on lot 1 of line 2, also known as the green line, between Vila Prudente and Dutra. The 7.3 km.-long section is being built for the company Metropolitano de São Paulo, Brazil.

The work has begun following the signing of the service order by the São Paulo Governor, João Doria, and the Secretary of Metropolitan Transport, Alexandre Baldy.

The consortium, consisting of Sacyr Infrastructures and Engineering, Galvão Engenharia and SA Paulista, will carry out the project with a budget of 443.2 million euros (1.9 billion Brazilian reais) and a construction period of 69 months.

The works will benefit the more than 300,000 daily users of the São Paulo metro.
